NSF LSAMP/CAMP & MURPPS are currently recruiting for a diverse pool of talented, motivated and qualified students to be the next scholars of the [NSF LSAMP/CAMP](#) and [MURPPS](#) Research Programs at UC Davis.

Program goals are to:
